History of Salem2Salem

The artists come from the fields of painting, photography, sculpture, multimedia, literature and music. The vast majority of this year's participants will participate for the first time. Also this year, the fact remains that it is given a non-issue. The artists are free to decide what they want to do in the three weeks between the 5th and 26th August. Let them to the location and the group, created on the spot one or the other work or use the lessons learned for future work?

Over the past four years, just showed it, in the triad of space, group and limited time, a productive force that produced exciting results. The concept of an international and interdisciplinary encounter, at a place in the "Province", has many of the previous participants allows a change of perspective and so released new creative energies. Herein we see the strength of salem2salem. This is where our project a little, though conscious, understands counterpoint to the dominance of an overheated international art market, the art almost exclusively as investment capital.

From the perspective of the Cultural Office of the Lake Constance district, this project is an important pillar of our cultural work, because international encounters and experiences allows the artists of our region that they could hardly ever or only under difficult conditions make. On the other hand salem2salem mean that the US artist space Upper Swabia and colleagues know of here and appreciate.

This year, the artists are not housed in Schloss Salem, as the recent accommodation of the Schule Schloss Salem be renovated this year. Instead, we are the living and working areas of the school in Castle Spetzgart in Ueberlingen available. Salem is and remains the intellectual center of the project. The opening of the project as well as the exhibition of the works created will be held here.
